

Of students surveyed, 76% use the Library daily or several times a week.

Most students responded that they use the Library primarily to study, followed by using the computers and doing research for a class.

Over 90% rated the environment in the Library, including lighting, study space, quiet areas and copying/printing services, from good to excellent.

Hours of operation remain an issue for many students.

## Coming Soon! ... Video Streaming

The Library is adding *Films on Demand* to its list of curriculum-oriented databases. It will be available mid-summer.

The Master Academic Package includes a collection of over 20,000 videos covering: Anthropology, Area Studies, Art & Architecture, Communications, Criminal Justice & Law, Education, English & Language Arts, History, Music & Dance, Philosophy & Religion, Political Science, Psychology, Sociology, Technology & Society, World Languages, Biology, Earth Science, Engineering, Environmental Science, Geography, Mathematics, Physical Science, Business & Economics, Health & Medicine, Nursing, World Cinema and Archival Films & Newsreels.

Films on Demand videos and authenticated clips can be easily embedded with persistent links into course management systems, including both Blackboard and Canvas. All of the titles in the package include captioning, interactive, searchable transcripts and citation information in MLA, APA and CMS formats.

Public performance rights are included for all titles.

## Study Rooms & Individual Users



At the end of the spring semester, the Library surveyed all study room reservation system users. Based on the results, the Library has made several modifications to the study room usage policy and procedures.

In addition to groups, individual students can now reserve study rooms online up to one week in advance.

All students can book up to a 3-hour session per day with a maximum of 12 hours per week.

The reservation checkout procedures have also been streamlined.

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
