Location: El Modena High School

Semester: Spring 2017 (February 13, 2017 - June 1, 2017)

Schedule: Mondays & Wednesdays, BIOL190 from 3:30p.m. - 5:20p.m. and BIOL190L from 5:30p.m. - 7:20p.m.

⇒ **Introduction to Biotechnology (BIOL 190):**

Recommended Preparation: **Mathematics 080**. Introduction to the field of biotechnology including a history of its origin and development, a survey of modern industrial applications and accomplishments, ethical considerations, and career paths. **CSU transferable.**

⇒ **Introduction to Biotechnology Lab (BIOL 190L):**

Co-requisite: Biology 190. Laboratory experiments emphasizing basic concepts needed for entry-level employment in the bioscience industry. Topics include chemistry of buffers, metrology, biological molecules, gene expression, cell structure, and molecular biology techniques. Introduces basic biotechnology skills including separation methods, aseptic technique, and documentation. Field trips may be required. **CSU transferable.**
