Thank you for accepting the invitation to participate on the **Technology for Institutional Effectiveness (TIE) Task Force**. As you are aware the college last summer requested support from the Institutional Effectiveness Partnership Initiative (IEPI) through its provision of tailor-fit Partnership Resource Teams. Specifically, SCC requested assistance in the identification of technology that can help manage the institution's integrated planning processes from the assessment and disaggregation of student learning outcome data through resource allocation and master planning efforts.

This past September I was notified of our approval by the Institutional Effectiveness Partnership Initiative Executive Committee to provide a Partnership Resource Team (PRT) this spring. We are delighted to join in this statewide effort to improve our effectiveness. Our first PRT visit is scheduled for Wednesday, March 29, 2017 with a follow-up visit on May 31, 2017.

You were identified to participate on the TIE Task Force based on your institutional role and experience with outcomes assessment, integrated planning and/or resource allocation. The TIE Task Force will lead the college in our interactions with the IEPI Partnership Resource Team and assist in the development of an Innovation & Effectiveness Plan that includes the identification of project objectives and associated planning elements, as well as a request for IEPI resources to fund the plan.

We have scheduled an orientation for **Friday, March 24th from 12-1pm in E-204** to ensure that each task force member is clear on their role and to outline the purpose and nature of the PRT visit.
