For students to meet this outcome their average should be 4/6 questions answered correctly, which is 67%.</p> <p>Results were 36/47 students met the outcome. 76.6% of class passed.</p> <p>Additional Data Attached</p>	<p>Only 28 students were able to answer question 8 correctly, which impacted the overall results. The remaining questions 40 or more students were able to answer correctly. The results are satisfactory, but the question missed was a true or false format, not difficult, and not one the instructor anticipated being so difficult for students.</p>	<p>Question 8 should be re-written or replaced. The topic was covered extensively for 4 weeks. Perhaps the word “symbolism” is not clear in the students’ mind. Propaganda would be a better term for the context of this course, in regard to testing clarity.</p> <p>Overall, I noticed some students bubbled in more than one answer, which skewed a few of the results. I cannot determine if this was intentional, knowing the assessment was not worth points, or if it was accidental. This deserves consideration and discussion for options of delivering the assessment questions.</p>
