See attached questions.</p>	<p>Percentage of questions answered correctly:</p> <p>7. 98% correct – 46/47 students met this outcome 8. 60% correct – 28/47 students met this outcome 9. 100% correct – 47/47 students met this outcome 10. 85% correct – 40/47 11. 28% correct – 13/47 12. 83% correct – 39/47</p> <p>Students met the criteria of success.</p>	<p>The overall average grade on outcome 2 was lower this spring than in 2012 due to the low scores on question 11. I did not show the “Rape of Europa” and cover this topic this semester. Question 11 needs to be replaced with something from 1400-1850, the time period covered in this course. I would like to replace it with something such as the Reformation and Counter-Reformation, as this topic is addressed repeatedly for weeks and any instructor teaching this course should be covering that material in depth – it shapes the foundations of modern Europe.</p> <p>Question 8 also had a low number of correct responses. The material was covered effectively and thoroughly in class in the first few weeks of the semester. Question is formatted like question 1 and seems to be a tricky format.</p>
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
