<p><u>SLO #1</u> Students will be able to analyze various perspectives of deafness.</p>	<p>Four questions addressing this SLO were administered as part of the cumulative final. Two of the questions were in multiple choice format and two were true/false.</p> <p>Students completed a reflection paper based on a deaf event or deaf media.</p> <p>Students earning a grade of C or better (70%) were determined to meet SLO criteria.</p>	<p>31 students completed the final. The following results reflect the percentage of correct responses for each question:</p> <p>Question #1 – 100% Question #2 – 90.3% Question #3 – 96.8% Question #4 – 96.8%</p> <p>Most students selected to complete their paper on deaf media.</p> <p>-30 students completed the paper earning an A grade - 2 students did not complete the assignment and received an F grade.</p>	<p>Student performance on these four sample questions averaged just over 95% which exceeded instructor expectations for successfully meeting this SLO.</p> <p>All students completing the reflection paper successfully met the requirements of the assignment and earned an A grade. The instructions for completing the paper are clear and students typically perform well on this assignment. These results demonstrate success in meeting this SLO</p>	<p>Re-introduce a pre and post test that will be improved and will ask a broad spectrum of questions regarding deafness. Assess if this tool will help determine if SLOs are met in addition to the general test questions as well as the reflection papers.</p>
