Analysis of Findings: The success rate for this criterion is considerably lower than the success rate for other criterion

Summary of Findings: Five sections participated in this assessment. There were 105 students measured. 42 students met the established criterion for success. This is a total passing percentage of 41%.

Results: Criteria for Success Achievement Status: Met

Analysis of Findings: The assessment is consistent with higher level teaching of Intermediate 1 ESL.

Recommendations: Continue to use the same assessment and criterion for success next semester. A recommendation of giving more test taking skills practice would be beneficial to students.

Analysis of Findings: The increased success for SLO 2 as opposed to SLO 1 demonstrates that instructors are focusing on writing skills and also the benefit of the written portion of the EL Civics modules
