Students receiving 70% or higher will demonstrate proficiency of knowledge.</p> <p>Students will also complete one (primary) writing assignment in which they will demonstrate ability to write, and knowledge of the material contained in the textbook and presented in the classroom. Students receiving 70% or higher will demonstrate proficiency of knowledge.</p>	<p>How many students received 70% or higher?</p> <p>61 students (56% of students who took the exam) earned 70% or higher.</p> <p>How many successfully completed the primary writing assignment with 70% or higher?</p> <p>77 students (71% of students who completed the writing assignment) earned 70% or higher.</p>	<p>Of the three classes offered at SCC what was the aggregate analysis of data? What did it mean, what does it look like?</p> <p>177 students started the courses, 108 students took the final exam, of which 56% earned a 70% or higher, and another 71% of students earned a 70% or higher on the writing assignment.</p>	<p>What would you do differently if at all?</p> <p>Faculty evaluate the assessment results and reflect on the content of the course material and the manner in which they present it to students.</p>
