Upon instructor evaluation each student educational plan should be 80% accurate.</p>	<p>Students N=32 turned in a completed first draft of their educational plan, reviewed feedback by instructor and completed a final version with 95% accuracy.</p>	<p>Counseling 106 is an intensive 16 hour college level course specifically designed to improve the retention and persistence of students majoring in the STEM fields. Students demonstrated knowledge of educational planning by exceeding the criteria of success by 15%.</p>	<p>Students shall meet with an academic counselor each semester to evaluate their educational plan and ensure they are remaining consistent with their educational goal(s).</p>
