Data collected from section taught by Dr. Umali Kopp.	The majority (32/34 = 94%) of students completed the final paper. Of those who completed the paper all but one (32/34 = 94%) earned a C grade or higher (i.e., 70% or greater) with 11 (34%) students in the A range, 17 (53%) students in the B (13%) range and 4 students in the C range.	Will discuss findings at the next department meeting.  Continue using the final paper as an assessment for this SLO.
