In addition there are 4 papers assigned in which the students analyze feature films; and the assessment is evaluated based on the following scale: 90 – 100% represents an Excellent knowledge base score; 80- 90% Good knowledge base; 70-79% Average knowledge base; 60-69% = Poor knowledge base 50 – 0%= Very Weak knowledge base. The desired outcome</p>	<p>73 students completed the class. 41% showed Excellent knowledge base; 38% Good knowledge base; 30% Average knowledge base; 0% Poor knowledge base and 6% Very Weak knowledge base. (most exhibiting Very Weak knowledge base didn't complete all of the written assignments.)</p>	<p>69% of the students evinced Excellent or Above Average knowledge base and 32% Evinced Average, Poor or Very Weak knowledge base. The desired outcome was achieved.</p>	<p>No further plan of action since the desired outcome was achieved.</p>
