Proposed Regulations to BOG Fee Waiver Changes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Mary gave an overview of the SSC Committee Mission Statement. She will be giving a summary of the meetings to Mike DeCarbo who will distribute to the Academic Senate Senators. She will also be representing and forwarding summaries for the PIE committee. In response to the Chancellor’s e-mail encouraging the use of the Early Alert program throughout the district, John and Mary created a document (distributed) which outlines the program and gives comparisons from year to year for “Utilization and Areas of Concern”. Suggestion to survey non-users to ask why they are not using the program and what other methods they may be using to alert their students. Faculty may be using Blackboard in some way for this purpose. Linda distributed information pertaining to “Loss of Enrollment Priority”. There was approximately a 500 loss in headcount but enrollment was up by 100 from last year. There was no impact on FTES because of the priority changes. Early Welcome information was also distributed. New this year was having students register on line in order of their orientation day. There were 1000 less students who registered during Early Welcome priority registration than last year. Discussion regarding high schools only requiring 2 years of math and the effects on students placing in lower math classes entering college. Mary highlighted some of the proposed changes to the BOG waiver that will start in the fall 2015 semester. Some items being proposed include: (1) if GPA <2.0, loss of BOG; now get BOG if <2.0 (2) BOG will be determined on a semester by semester basis; now yearly; (3) no BOG if >100 units, now get BOG with >100 units; (4) BOG-B which is now based on self report of income may go away.
