Summary of data and/or major themes:

When reviewing SCC scorecard data, the following themes are noted:

- SCC completion cohort size seems flat, while other Orange County colleges are growing.
- SCC completion rate is on a slight decline from the last 5 years; but we are still above the state completion rate.
 - The state completion rate is also on a slight decline.
 - Most Orange County community college districts are on a slight decline except South Orange County CCD & Cypress College. What is Cypress doing well?
- SCC Equity Gap is increasing
- SCC Persistence and 30 unit Metric are maintaining steady rates

Recommended Enrollment Management (EM) goals supported by data:

- Increase completion rate
- Decrease equity gap

Suggested necessary additional data (optional):

- Identify the proportion of completers who wait to attempt math or English courses. Are there completers that are excluded from the Scorecard cohort because they did not attempt math or English in their first three years?
- Search for predictors of non-success for lowest performing groups through advanced statistical analyses and increase use of predictive analytics college-wide.

Other thoughts or comments (optional):

Notes on Scorecard data:

- Cohorts began 6 years ago- and SCC has developed new student support programs since then. These data do not necessarily reflect the benefit of those programs yet.
- Students are tracked by Social Security Numbers.
