HOW TO GET A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA OR PREPARE FOR THE GED

If you are an adult (**at least 18 years of age**) and are interested in getting your high school diploma or taking preparation courses, **you must** schedule an appointment to take the **HSS Reading Proficiency** at any of the locations listed above. The proficiency will assist a counselor in determining the appropriate class level for you. If you wish to transfer credits for classes you have already completed at an accredited secondary school, you must bring in a transcript (an official transcript will be required in order to receive a high school diploma through our program). Classes are **FREE** and are open entry/open exit throughout the year. A counselor will discuss the specifics about **your credit** requirements and class schedule with you after you have taken the high school reading proficiency.

PROCEDURES TO TAKE THE HSS / GED PLACEMENT ASSESSMENT

- 1) **Visit** the High School Diploma Program Counseling Office at one of the addresses noted above. You can also call the counseling office for general information at SCC-714-628-5929 or CWPC-714-628-5999 (such as credit, age or transcript requirements) or if you need further instructions on registering for our Adult High Diploma or GED reading proficiency.
- 2) During your initial visit to the counseling office, you will be required to schedule a follow up appointment to meet with a counselor to review the assessment results.
- 3) On the day of your assessment, please report to the Counseling Office at Santiago Canyon College (SCC) – **Room U-80**, or at the College and Workforce Preparation Center (CWPC), **Front Office**, with your **Registration Confirmation** or your OEC Student ID Card with you.
