## Faculty Feedback Form



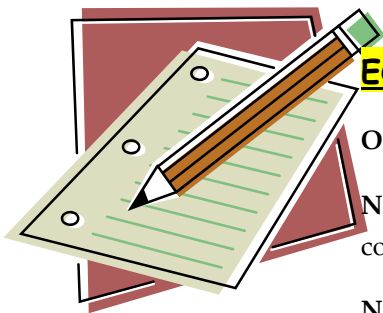
