Unknown Location (Mismatch) for **2020-2021**

- According to your school record, on your college Admissions application you named Santa Ana College as your home location school, BUT
- On your FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) you listed Santiago Canyon College (SCC) as your home location school.

This is causing a mis-match discrepancy that we need you to correct. Both the FAFSA and your home location school must be the same.

To correct this you must do ONE of the following options:

- **Change your home location to Santiago Canyon College** by taking this letter to the Admissions and Records Office (at either SAC or SCC). Admissions & Records staff will change the home location on your student record and will complete the section on the bottom of this form. **Then you must return this form to the SCC Financial Aid Office** so that we can correct our records and begin processing your financial aid file.

OR

- Make the change on your FAFSA to add the school code 001284 for Santa Ana College. You can do this online by going to fafsa.gov and under “Returning User?” follow the link to “Add a School.” After you do this, Santa Ana College Financial Aid Office can begin processing your financial aid once they receive your corrected FAFSA.
