Length of academic year: 2 semesters = 9 months

1 semester = 4.5 months

Resident Fees:

Based on the district census of 14, the average full-time enrollment was 14 units per semester.

14 units @ \$46/unit = \$644

The Enrollment Fee for the fall 20 and spring 21 academic year = \$1,288.

The Health Fee is \$19 per semester x 2 semesters = \$38 for the academic year.

Transportation Fee \$5 per semester x 2 semesters = \$10 for the academic year.

Representation Fee \$2.00 semester x 2 semesters = \$4 for the academic year.

Total Resident Fees = \$1,340

The California College Promise Grant (CCPG) amount does not include the Health Fee \$1,288 = Academic Year and \$644 = one semester

Non-Resident Tuition is \$325 per unit

Non-Resident Tuition will be added to the Cost of Education depending on the number of units of the student's enrollment. Non-residents pay the resident enrollment fee and the non-resident tuition fee.

Non-Resident Budget for Less than Half-Time Enrollment

Non-Residents who are enrolled in less than half-time units will have 5.9 units of non-resident tuition added to their budget.

(5.9 x \$325 = \$1,917.50) for one semester and \$3835 for two semesters (11.8 units).

LESS THAN HALF TIME BUDGETS: No adjustments will be made for less than half-time budgets for the following: vocational programs, computer purchase or expenses related to disabilities.
