



Santiago Canyon College Dreamer Student Emergency Aid Grant

\$500 or more Emergency Grants are available to AB-540 and DACA students with an urgent need assessed on a case by case basis. The DACA application fee of \$495 will qualify for this emergency funding and you do not have to repay this money back!

One-time, limited funds have been made available from the State to assist Dreamer students who have a specific emergency need related to their educational cost of attendance for the 2017-2018 academic year. This includes:

- School fees
- Books & supplies
- Food
- Housing
- Transportation
- Personal expenses
- Childcare

Qualifications & How to Apply:

- 1) Student has urgent need for funds to relieve emergency situation**
- 2) Actively attending at least 3 units at Santiago Canyon College (SCC) or Santa Ana College (SAC)**
- 3) Residency Status is noted as AB-540 or DACA with SCC Admissions & Records**
- 4) Student has declared SCC as his/her Home Location with the SCC Admissions & Records Office**
- 5) Either:**
 - (a) SCC Financial Aid Office has already received a valid 2017-18 California Dream Act Application from the student; OR**
 - (b) Student must complete a California Dream Act Application at: <https://dream.csac.ca.gov/>**
- 6) Complete the following and submit to the SCC Financial Aid Office in Building E, Room 104: [Dreamer Student Emergency Aid Grant Request Form](#)**
- 7) The First Year Support Center (E-307) is available to assist students with filling out this application if needed.**

NOTE: U.S. citizens and eligible non-citizens who qualify for non-resident tuition waiver under AB-540 are excluded from receiving any emergency funds from this program.
