DEFAULT RESOLUTION

The National Student Loan Data System (NSLDS) reported that you are in **DEFAULT** on a federal student loan which makes you **ineligible** to receive any federal student aid. The Santiago Canyon College (SCC) Financial Aid Office (FAO) **cannot proceed with processing your file** until we receive documentation from you showing you have resolved the default.

1. **If you have paid off your student loan**, provide a copy of the documentation from your lender/servicer showing the loan is paid in full.
2. **If you have consolidated** your defaulted loans, provide a copy of the documentation from the lender/servicer.
3. **If you have successfully made six consecutive monthly payments** to the holder of your loan, you are now eligible for Title IV student aid. Provide documentation from your lender/servicer that indicates you are **now eligible for reinstatement**.
