



REQUEST FOR FEDERAL TAX RETURN or TAX TRANSCRIPT

Submit either of the following tax documents to the Financial Aid Office:

- A **SIGNED copy of your 2017 Federal Tax Return** (form 1040, 1040A, or 1040EZ), including all schedules, **OR**
- An **IRS 2017 Tax Return Transcript**. Order at www.irs.gov (see instructions below).

If you are unable to submit a SIGNED copy of your Federal Tax Returns, you can obtain a Tax Return Transcript by following the options listed below:

- Order online at www.irs.gov (see screen shot below). **OR**
- Call 1-800-908-9946 to request a faxed copy. You must be at the fax machine when ordering. **OR**
- Complete a 4506-T Form and mail directly to IRS. Find form at: www.irs.gov/pub/irs-pdf/f4506tez.pdf
