## More Than a Promise...

The Santiago Canyon College (SCC) Promise Scholarship provides incoming, full-time students with one year of college, tuition free. SCC will provide you with the support and guidance needed to reach your educational and career goals. You will receive continuous academic and support services such as: Student Success Workshops, Academic Coaching, one-on-one counseling, tutoring, career exploration, and transfer advisement to a four-year university.

## How does the Promise Scholarship benefit me?

The SCC Promise helps first-time students complete their associate degree, transfer requirements, or workforce certificate(s) by providing access to a high quality education. Ranked #13 Best Community College in the U.S., SCC offers two Promise Scholarships that are not based on family income:

- #1 All 2018 high school graduates are eligible to receive the SCC Promise of free tuition for the first year.
- #2 Students that have financial need, (determined by the FAFSA), may also be awarded a \$400 book voucher to the SCC Hawk Bookstore (\$200/semester).

## Success Starts Right Here, Right Now!

- STEP 1:** Submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or the California Dream Act Application for AB 540/Dreamers. Be sure to indicate Santiago Canyon College school code (036957) as your home location. Forms can be found at: [fafsa.ed.gov](http://fafsa.ed.gov) or [dream.csac.ca.gov](http://dream.csac.ca.gov)
- STEP 2:** Go to the SCC First Year Support Center in **E-307** after submitting the FAFSA or Dream Act application to verify your award.
- STEP 3:** Register as a full-time student in 12 units or more. It's not too late to enroll in additional units; 8-week classes are still available!

### Act Quickly!

Students will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis until funds are depleted.

## Program Requirements:

- Students must be a California resident or AB 540 eligible.
- Remain continuously enrolled in 12 units or more during the Fall 2018 and Spring 2019 semesters. Students with verified disabilities impacting their ability to maintain 12 units may still qualify.
- Must maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA.
- Meet with your Academic Coach in the First Year Support Center once each semester during your first year.
