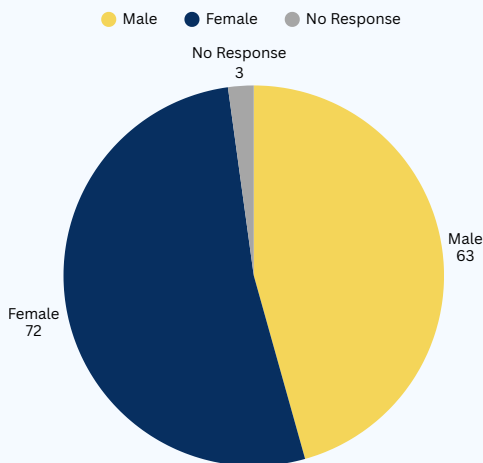
For academic year (July 1st, 2025-June 30th, 2026), the Office of Student Development received a total of 146 reports.

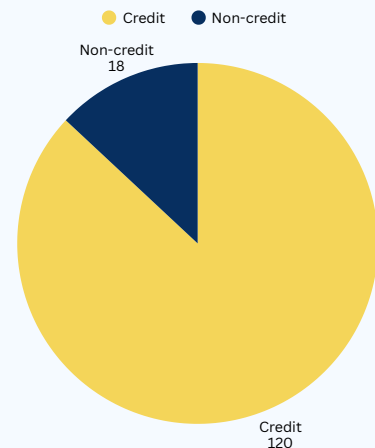

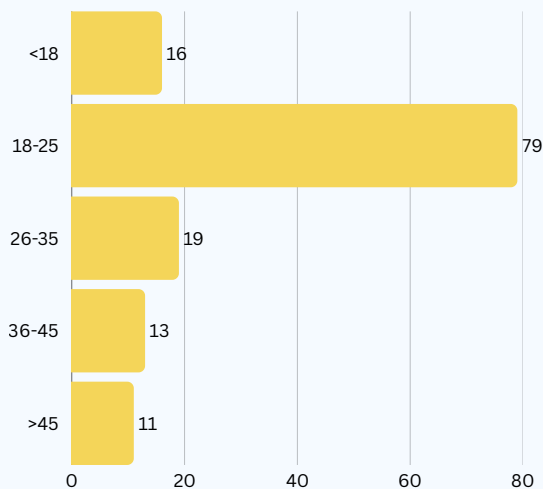

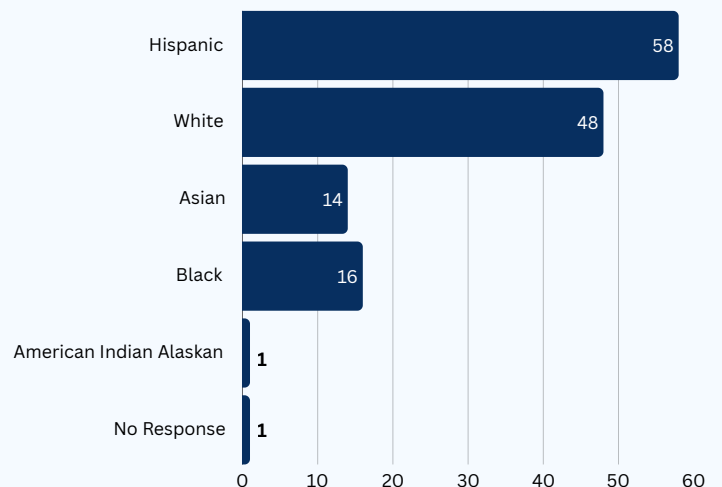

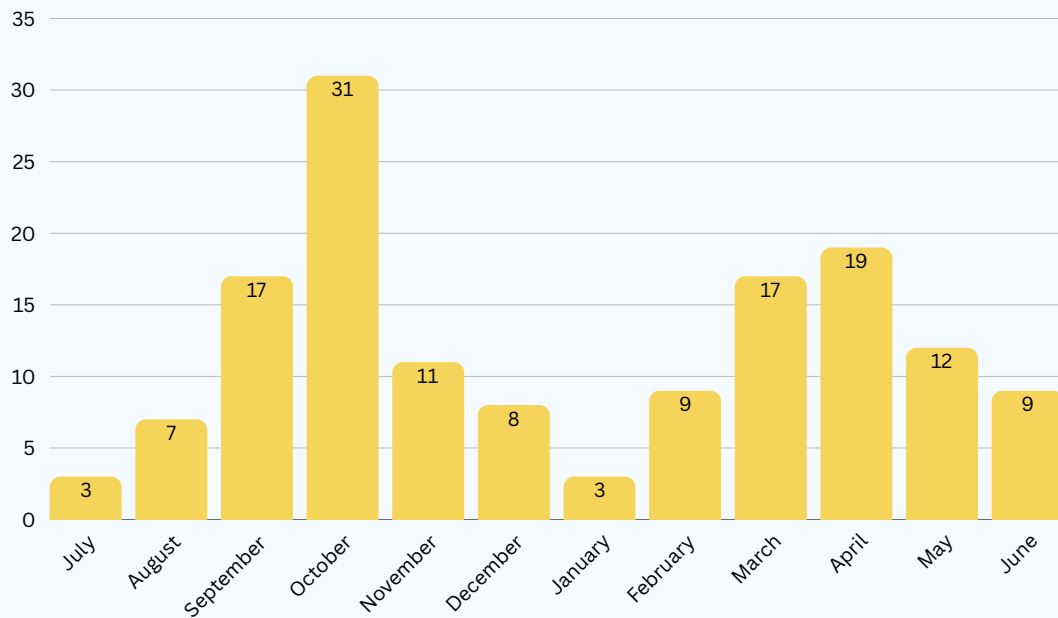


Ethnicity

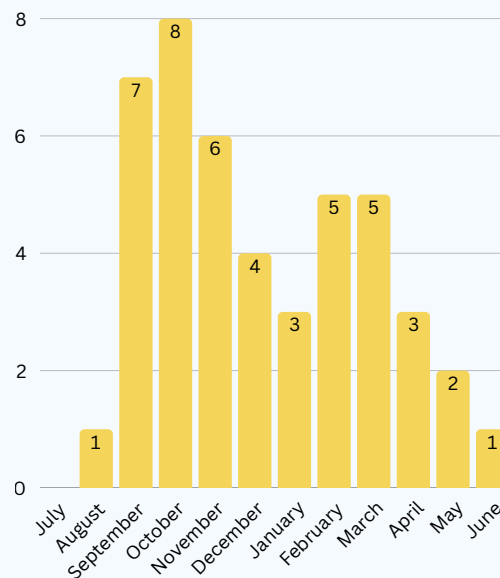

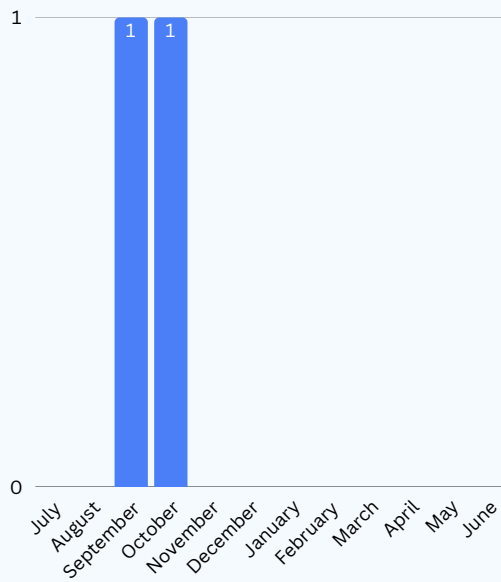

TYPE OF REPORTS

Academic: Reports on academic misconduct. Examples include, but are not limited to cheating, plagiarism, fabrication or falsification of data, or use of paid or unpaid services to complete an assignment.

CARE: Reports of non-urgent and concerning observed student behavior. Examples include, but are not limited to: Housing or Food Insecurity; Suicidal Thoughts; or Life Stressors

Civil Rights: Reports of a potential violation of Administrative Regulation 3435. Rancho Santiago Community College District prohibits discrimination and harassment of any kind based on age, religious creed, color, national origin, ancestry, physical disability, mental disability, medical condition, genetic information, marital status, sex, gender, gender identity, gender expression, age, or sexual orientation of any person, or military and veteran status, or because they are perceived to have one or more of the preceding characteristics in the programs and activities that it operates, and is required by federal law not to discriminate.

Conduct: Reports of student behavior's that violates the Standards of Student Conduct. Examples include but are not limited to: Alcohol or Drug Use; Disruptive Behavior; Threats; or Violence.

Duplicate: Reports that were submitted twice

Information Only: Reports that are classified as "information only" may not have identified respondents and/or complainants. Reports have been saved to our system as documentation, and for future reference.

Title IX: Reports of all allegations involving other protected statuses may be reported using the Civil Rights reporting form. Please complete this form to report any possible violations of Prohibited Conduct under Administrative Regulation 3425.
